TUITION FEES

Full Time Students

- 6 months of training- 4 months of theory and up two months to complete internship
- 2 full days per week
- 200 hour internship
- All materials and training manual provided
- \$28,000

Part Time Students

- 24 months of training- 18 months of theory and up to 6 months to complete internship
- 1.5 hours per week
- 200 hour internship
- Training manual provided
- \$1,200 per month for 18
- \$500 per term lab fee (6 terms)

PAYMENT PLAN

For full time students, we understand that this is a significant investment, so we offer payment plans to help you manage your finances. If you prefer to pay in instalments, your options are as follows:

50% upon registration with the balance due at the end of month three

25% upon registration and 25% each at the end on months 2, 3 and 4
